# 1. Why is my current plan being discontinued?

Like other plan providers across the nation, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Illinois (BCBSIL) is

updating the plans we offer to make sure we are offering plans that have the benefits our members may need at a price they can afford.



## 2. Why are you moving me to a new plan?

We're moving you to a new plan because your current plan is being discontinued and we want

to be sure there is no gap in your health care coverage.



# 3. What if I want to choose a different plan?

You are under no obligation to remain with the plan we have selected for you.

Just visit StayBluelL.com on November 1, 2015, to review your BCBSIL options for 2016. We have other options you can choose. Be sure to check and see if your doctors, hospitals, and pharmacies are in your new plan's network.



# 4. What should I do if I'm okay with the plan you're moving me to?

Your new plan coverage is all set to begin on January 1, 2016. Just continue to pay your monthly premiums on time. 
## 5. When should I choose a new plan?

Yearly open enrollment is scheduled from November 1, 2015, through January 31, 2016 (dates subject to change). Choose a plan on or before December 31, 2015, for coverage under the new plan to start on January 1, 2016. You will be covered by the plan we chose for you on January 1, 2016 if you don't pick another plan. You will still have until January 31, 2016 to change plans.

# 7. How can I find out if my prescription drugs are covered under my new plan?

# 8. When will coverage under my new plan start?

The plan and coverage we've selected for you will begin on January 1, 2016. You'll receive

new ID card(s) and your *Summary of Benefits & Coverage*. The only thing you have to do is use your benefits and pay your monthly premiums on time.



# 9. What will happen if I choose a different plan?

If you want a different plan, you have until December 31, 2015, to make your choice and enroll for coverage beginning on January 1, 2016. You'll receive new ID card(s) and your *Summary of Benefits & Coverage.* Just remember to check and see if your doctors, hospitals and pharmacies are in your new plan's network, and continue to pay your monthly premiums.



#### 10. What are managed care plans?

The goal of managed care is to keep health care costs down without sacrificing quality of care. Managed care plans offer a dedicated

network of doctors, hospitals, and pharmacies to coordinate and provide quality care.

Health Maintenance Organizations (HMO) and Point of Service (POS) plans are two of the most common types of managed care plans available to individuals. Both plan types require you to choose a Primary Care Physician (PCP) from the plan's provider network.

That means you'll have a doctor who knows your health history and will coordinate your care within our network to be sure you get the right care at the right place at the right time.



#### 11. Will I be able to get adult dental coverage with a new plan?

Yes. When you choose your new health plan online, you'll see an option to add adult dental coverage. You can only add dental

during open enrollment or a special enrollment period.



# 12. If I have an agent today, will I keep the same agent?

Yes, unless you call to change your agent information.



#### 13. If I choose a new plan outside the Marketplace for 2016, do I need to cancel my current Marketplace plan?

If you bought a Marketplace plan through BCBSIL or www.getcoveredillinois.gov in 2015, and you buy a new plan outside the Marketplace this year, you will need to log in to www.getcoveredillinois.gov to cancel the plan you bought last year.



# 14. Are there ways for me to save money on my medical costs?
